Work more efficiently in Excel with these Excel shortcuts

The experts at FMI have created this easy-to-follow Excel shortcut guide. There are 127 Excel shortcuts on the following pages, categorized into a way that makes sense.

Where keys need to be pressed together, it will be displayed like this:



Which means press Control and A together

Where keys need to be pressed one after each other, it will be displayed like this:



Which means press Alt and H together, then release those keys and press A, then B
